Founded as the Remington Art Memorial in 1923; became the Frederic Remington Art Museum in 1981. Accredited by the American Association of Museums.

Mission: The mission of the Frederic Remington Art Museum is to collect, exhibit, preserve and interpret the art and archives of Frederic Remington. We foster an appreciation for and an understanding of the artist by educating our audience in the visual arts, providing a context for Remington's art and times, and offering hands-on opportunities to individuals of all age groups.

Hours: May 15 - October 15: Mon. – Sat. 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. & Sun. 1 to 5 p.m.
October 16 - May 14: Wed. – Sat. 11 a.m. to 5 p.m. & Sun. 1 to 5 p.m.

Total number of visitors per year: 14,000 -16,000 visitors annually

Annual operating budget: Approximately \$820,000

Revenue sources: Gifts, grants, gift shop sales, admissions, events, memberships, exhibit and artwork rental, licensing agreements

Annual gifts and grants received: About \$500,000 - \$600,000 including \$160,000 from the City of Ogdensburg.

Size of collection: Over 5,000 items in the collection, including: 22 major oil paintings; 17 bronzes; hundreds of published works on paper; watercolors, studies, and sketches; journals, letters, and personal effects

Physical Plant: Three adjacent historic buildings and the 6,000-square-foot Newell Wing completed in 1997. These are: The Parish Mansion and Newell Wing, which house the museum and galleries; 311 Washington Street, which contains administrative offices and meeting space; and the Eva Caten Remington Education Center, which includes interactive galleries for children, a classroom, and offices.

Size of Staff: 7 full time and 3 part time employees. Positions are NYS Civil Service; full time employees receive City of Ogdensburg health benefits and NYS retirement.
