

VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES AT THE FREDERIC REMINGTON ART MUSEUM

EDUCATION

Docent

Engages visitors of all ages in conversations about and active explorations of the work of Frederic Remington; provides pre-arranged tours and gallery talks, and/or interface with visitors on a drop-in basis in the galleries; maintains thorough knowledge of exhibitions, educational programming, and events at the FRAM through ongoing training; is friendly, welcoming, and proactive in seeking out visitor contact

Lobby/Gallery attendant

Greets and directs visitors and secures the galleries; is friendly, welcoming, and proactive in seeking out visitor contact; educates visitors about Museum exhibitions, programs, and membership; assists staff with other tasks upon request; maintains thorough knowledge of exhibitions, educational programming, and events at the FRAM

School tour volunteer

Works with museum educator in bringing school tours and other kids' groups through the Museum and Kid's Place so that their visit is satisfying and enriching

Kid's Place Volunteer

Helps children and their caretakers have an enriching and enjoyable educational experience in our children's museum; interacts with families during open hours; helps keep the public spaces safe and fun

Youth Programs Volunteer

Helps youth have enriching educational experiences; works with children in creation of art projects; gathers and prepares supplies; helps with set-up and clean-up; assists with demonstration and use of materials

Adult Programs Volunteer

Assists Museum educator in running art classes and other programs; helps with program set-up and clean-up

Instructor/Presenter

Teaches a hands-on art class, or delivers a presentation on a topic relating to the work of Frederic Remington or Sally James Farnham

Tea Series

Helps to organize the Museum's annual series of lectures and teas; helps with set-up, tea service, and clean-up

EVENTS

Event planning and support

Helps to organize public events at the Museum, especially fundraisers; helps planners with tasks (e.g. picking up donations) that make our events successful

Event staffing

Helps with set-up and clean-up, greeting guests, assisting with activities

Event Photographer

Helps document museum events with our digital camera, or with your own cell phone

MARKETING & COMMUNICATIONS

Digital Engagement Volunteer

Helps develop content for the Museum's Facebook and website pages

Museum Shop Clerk

Assists in making sales, inventory, labeling, arranging merchandise, etc.

Mailing Volunteer

Helps get regular mailings processed and ready for bulk mail post

Editor

Proofreads text for newsletter and other communications

Ambassador

Represents the Museum at public events throughout the region.

BUILDING & GROUNDS

Maintenance helper

Assists in keeping up the museum, often partnering with Property Manager for two-person jobs, or carrying out specialty one-person jobs. The job can cover everything from cleaning to building and equipment repair.

Lawn and Garden volunteers

Helps to keep our outdoor spaces looking their best by periodic weeding, mulching, or other tidying up
